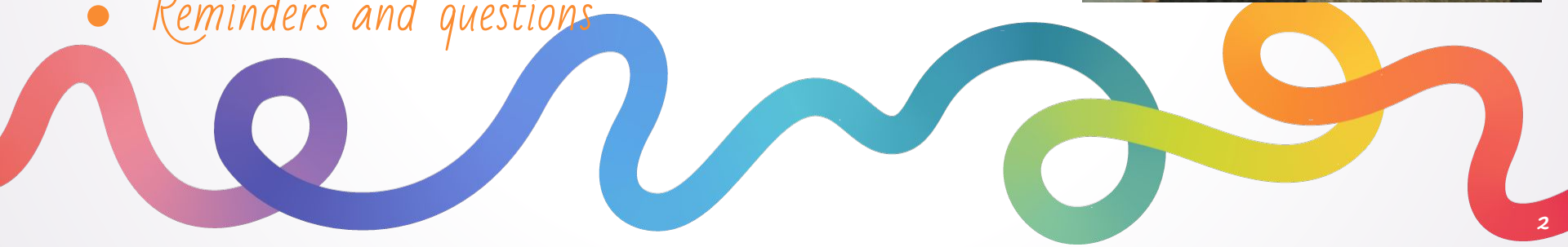

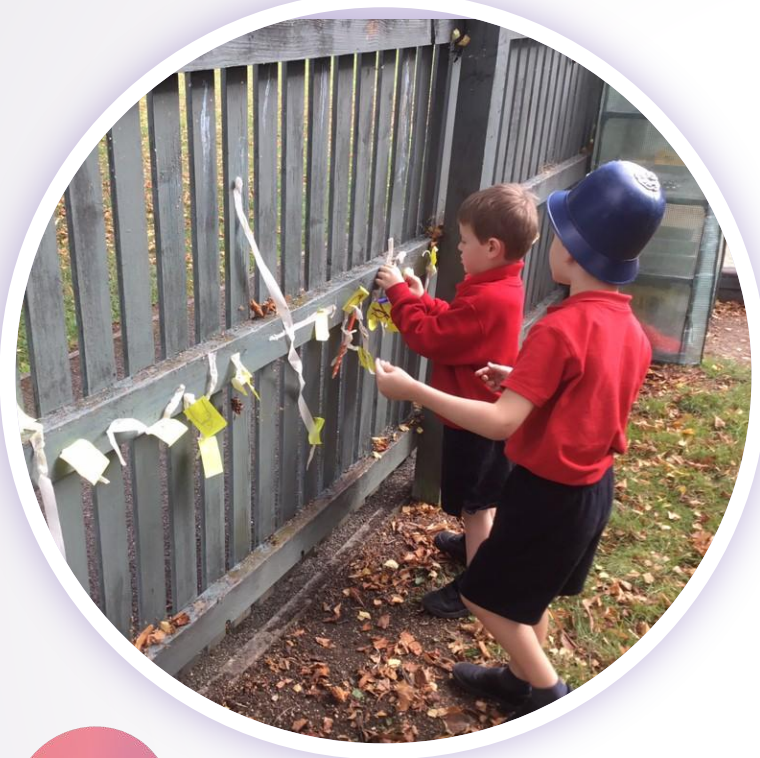

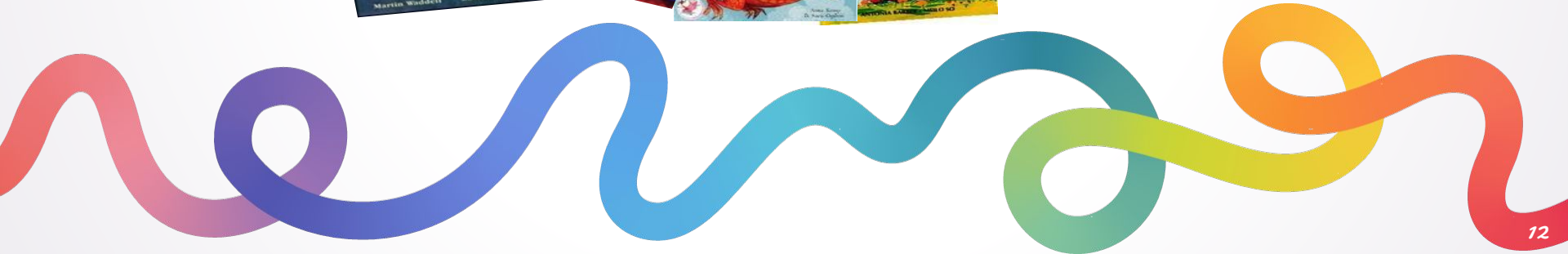
## Phonics

# Handwriting phrases for helping your child to form letters

This works best if your child practises for a short time every day.

1. Show the picture side and air-write as you say the phrase.
2. Ask your child to practise in the air with you.
3. Using a sharp pencil and sat at a table, encourage your child to have a go.
4. Praise your child for their efforts.

# RECEPTION BASELINE ASSESSMENT



Standards  
& Testing  
Agency

- *The reception baseline assessment (RBA) will be completed within the first 6 weeks.*
- *It provides the starting point to measure the progress schools make between reception and the end of primary school.*
- *The RBA is a short, interactive and practical assessment of your child's early literacy, communication, language and mathematics skills.*
- *It is statutory for all schools from September 2021.*
- *We receive a set of statements which provide a narrative description of how your child performed in the assessment.*



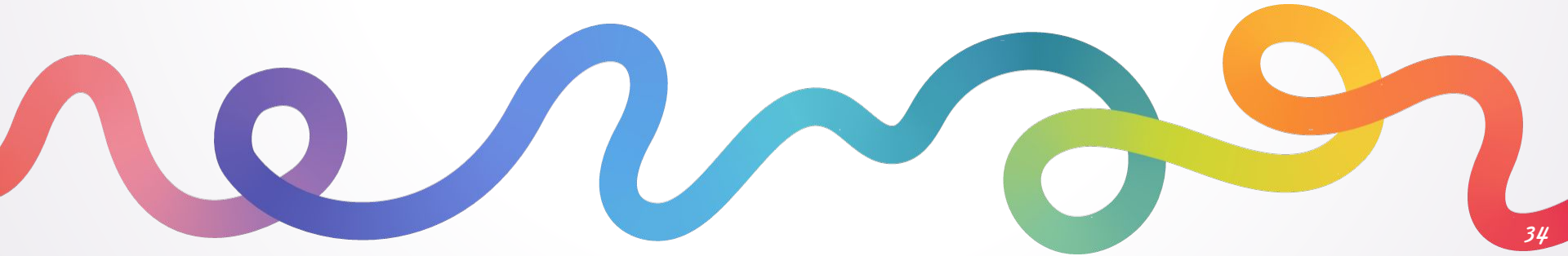
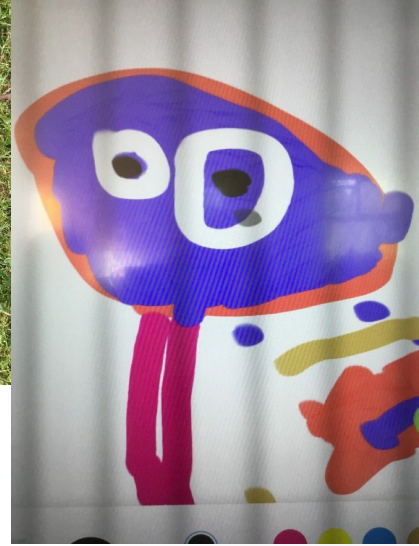
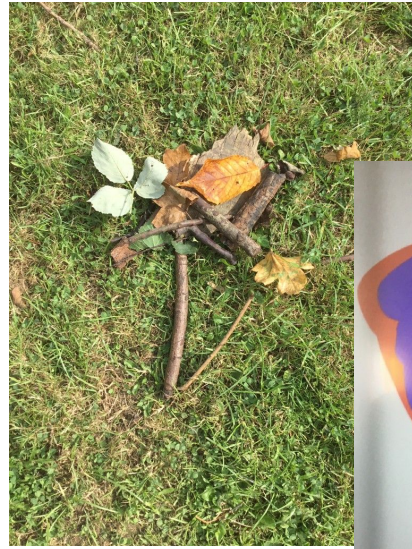
